Buster, an author and script/story consultant to the likes of Disney, Pixar, BBC and former creative executive for Hollywood greats Tony Scott (*The Good Wife*), Ray Stark (*Steel Magnolias*) and Larry Gelbart (*Tootsie*), presents five seminars exploring the factors – in scriptwriting, screen craft and people's senses – that help take storytelling to the next level by learning what makes a great story well told.
