



MIFF'S 37South2008: BREAKTHROUGH SCREENINGS SELECTIONS ANNOUNCED

MELBOURNE: 09 July 2008 – Ten films have been selected for the first-ever **37South: Breakthrough Screenings** by **37South2008**, the film co-financing market of the Melbourne International Film Festival (**MIFF**).

The **37South: Breakthrough Screenings** are screenings of selected new Australian films seeking world sales agents and/or local distribution for invited international and local buyers attending **MIFF's 37South: Bridging the Gap.** The producer of each film selected for the **37South: Breakthrough Screenings** program receives a registration for **37South: Bridging the Gap**'s program of scheduled one-to-one meetings with local and international financiers/buyers, plus roundtables and networking events.

"It is an exciting step for MIFF's 37South to add these new market screenings to the 37South family of market activities and to offer the producers of these titles the opportunity to meet with **37South**: **Bridging the Gap**'s more than 30 film co-financiers and buyers."

37South2008 runs 24-27 July 2008 at MIFF, Australia's oldest and largest festival, and includes **37South: Bridging** the Gap, **37South: Breakthrough Screenings**, **37South: Accelerator Express**, **37South: PostScript&Direct** and **37South's Books at MIFF (BaM)**.
