MIFF 37°South Market: CLOSES WITH PRODUCERS HEADING TO LONDON & ABU DHABI

MELBOURNE, 26 July 2009: MIFF 37°South Market, the Melbourne International Film Festival (MIFF) film co-financing event running 23-26 July 2009, closed its third edition on Sunday, with the announcement of the producers who were awarded the inaugural MIFF 37°South Market Alliance places at the London **Production Finance Market (PFM)** and Abu Dhabi **Circle** – both of which occur in October.

The winning producer of the London **PFM** place is New Zealand-based Robin Scholes (ONCE WERE WARRIORS, RAIN) and the winning producer of the Abu Dhabi **Circle** place is Sydney-based Miranda Culley (Associate Producer RABBIT PROOF FENCE, co-producer with Marian Macgowan on Shirley Barrett's upcoming SOUTH SOLITARY). The producers were presented their winning places by Sue Milliken of Film Finances – **MIFF 37°South Market**'s Gold Sponsor.

The MIFF 37°South Market-PFM Alliance and MIFF 37°South Market-Circle Alliance ensured that each producer selected to participate in the 2009 MIFF 37°South Market were automatically considered for a place at the each of the October 2009 events. MIFF 37°South Market international financing guests, together with the PFM's Helena Mackenzie and the Circle's David Shepheard, considered all registered MIFF 37°South Market producers and selected one producer to attend each event.

This year, MIFF 37°South Market, Australia's only film co-financing market to be held at a film festival brought some 37 film financiers/buyers to Melbourne who met with 70 producers from across Australia/NZ who were selected for registration at the market. Across the various strands of market, which include 37°South: Bridging the Gap, 37°South: PostScript&Direct, and 37°South's Books at MIFF, the number of scheduled one-to-one meetings increased 28% to 1,041 from last year's total of 814 (which was triple 2007's tally).

This year's MIFF 37°South Market international film financiers/buyers included Paramount (USA), Match Factory (Europe), National Geographic Films (USA), Hanway (Europe), Visit Films (USA), Bankside (Europe), Media8 (USA), Pathe (Europe), ArcLight (USA/Australia), Ealing (Europe), H20 (USA), Bavaria (Europe), Standard & Chartered (Asia), Fortissimo (Europe/Asia), QuickFire (Europe), along with such Australian/NZ companies as Roadshow, HopScotch, Transmission, Madman, Arkles, ABC-TV, Accent and Rialto.

The co-financiers/buyers also viewed completed local seeking distribution and/or sales agents in the **37°South: Breakthru Screenings**, and attended the **MIFF 2009** world premieres of **MIFF Premiere Fund** cofinanced titles BALIBO, INDONESIA CALLING and BLESSED.
