MIFF 37°South Market: OPENS WITH NEW INTERNATIONAL PARTNERSHIP

MELBOURNE, 23 July 2009: Victorian State Premier John Brumby last night welcomed a large contingent of international and Australia/NZ film financier/buyers to Melbourne as he officially opened the third edition of **MIFF 37°South Market**, the Melbourne International Film Festival (**MIFF**) film co-financing event running 23-26 July 2009, and announced a new strategic partnership with the Abu Dhabi **Circle** financing conference.

The MIFF 37°South Market-Circle Alliance, which mirrors the existing MIFF 37°South Market-London Production Finance (PFM) Alliance, ensures that each producer selected to participate in the 2009 MIFF 37°South Market will automatically be considered for a place at the October 2009 edition of the Abu Dhabi Circle. The Circle-37°South alliance provides the first guaranteed place for an Australian/NZ producer at the Abu Dhabi event. MIFF 37°South Market international financing guests, together with Circle organisers, will consider all registered MIFF 37°South Market producers and will select one producer to attend 2009's Circle.

Similarly, **PFM** organisers and **MIFF 37°South Market** international financing guests will consider all registered **MIFF 37°South Market** producers and projects and will select one lucky producer to attend the October 2009 **PFM**. The winning producers of the **Circle** and **PFM** places will be announced at the **MIFF 37°South Market** 2009 closing drinks on Sunday 26 July 2009

This year, **MIFF 37°South Market**, Australia's only film co-financing market to be held at a film festival, has secured some 37 film financiers/buyers who will meet with 70 producers from across Australia/NZ who were selected for registration at the market. Across the various strands of market, which include **37°South: Bridging the Gap**, **37°South: PostScript&Direct**, and **37°South's Books at MIFF**, the number of scheduled one-to-one meetings has increased 28% to 1,041 from last year's total of 814 (which was triple 2007's tally).

This year's **MIFF 37°South Market** international film financiers/buyers include Paramount (USA), Match Factory (Europe), National Geographic Films (USA), Hanway (Europe), Visit Films (USA), Bankside (Europe), Media8 (USA), Pathe (Europe), ArcLight (USA/Australia), Ealing (Europe), H20 (USA), Bavaria (Europe), Standard & Chartered (Asia), Fortissimo (Europe/Asia), QuickFire (Europe), along with such Australian/NZ companies as Roadshow, HopScotch, Transmission, Madman, Arkles, ABC-TV, Accent and Rialto.

The co-financiers/buyers will also view completed local seeking distribution and/or sales agents (and take follow-up meetings) in the **37°South: Breakthru Screenings**, as well as attend the **MIFF 2009** world premieres of **MIFF Premiere Fund** co-financed titles BALIBO, INDONESIA CALLING and BLESSED.

At last night's event, it was also announced that the **MIFF Premiere Fund** today opened applications for Round Six of the MIFF Premiere Fund seeking films that can be ready to premiere at MIFF 2010. For more details, go to <u>www.miffpremierefund.com</u>.
